CMA CGM Group and MPA to Develop Maritime Decarbonisation Capabilities

<u>CMA CGM Group</u> and <u>MPA</u> have signed a <u>memorandum of understanding</u> to develop capabilities across maritime decarbonisation, digitalisation and innovation.

In particular, they will explore the use of low carbon fuels and develop green technologies such as carbon capture solutions.



EPS, MPA, Hyundai Heavy Industries and ABS Sign MoU for Ocean-going Ammonia Dual-Fuel Gas Tanker

Eastern Pacific Shipping (EPS), the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA), Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI), and the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS) on 6 June 2022 signed a MoU for an ocean-going ammonia dual-fuel gas tanker.

The signing, taking place at Posidonia, also saw <u>EPS</u> announcing its intention to order an ammonia dual-fuel gas carrier which will be built at <u>HHI</u>, to be registered under the Singapore flag, classed by <u>ABS</u>, and will be the first vessel fitted with <u>MAN</u> <u>Energy Solutions</u>' G60 two-stroke dual-fuel ammonia engine.
