SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES

The <u>MaritimeONE Scholarship Programme</u> identifies and cultivates young maritime talent by preparing them for the industry.



It applies to a wide range of local and overseas diploma and degree courses. Beyond financial support, MaritimeONE scholars can also benefit from specially curated activities that guide them through their educational and early professional journeys.



The <u>MaritimeONE Bursary Fund</u> provides support to students from financially disadvantaged backgrounds. It ensures that the doors to quality education remain open to Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents to expand the talent pool for the maritime sector.



INTERNSHIP PROGRAMMES

These programmes provide students from different disciplines with an enriching maritime experience in Singapore and/or abroad, enhancing their employability and career opportunities within the maritime industry.

MaritimeONE Internship Programmes (MIP) provides tertiary talent with immersive and experiential learning opportunities that enhance the visibility of maritime employers to the talent pool.

- Open to LLB and Juris Doctor students from all years of study

MPA Global Internship Award fully sponsors students to gain onthe-job experience and global exposure at reputable international maritime companies. It is a 12-week programme, inclusive of an overseas component of up to 6 weeks.






CAREER PORTAL

MPA-SMF JOINT OFFICE FOR TALENT AND SKILLS

The <u>MPA-SMF Joint Office for Talent and Skills</u> is a focal point for collaboration among stakeholders to support the upskilling and transformation of Maritime Singapore's workforce.



It aims to consolidate talent-related feedback, provide practical advice, and aggregate training demand. The Joint Office also works with training providers to develop high-quality, competency-based courses in emerging areas such as data science, Al and sustainability.

To support its objectives, the Joint Office partners the National University of Singapore in its <u>applied data science and analytics courses for maritime professionals</u>.
